Credit 1.1 **Optimize Energy Performance—Lighting Power** 3 points
Leaf personal lights use a highly efficient LED light source that can help reduce the overall lighting power required for the project.

Material and Resources

Credit 2.1 **Construction Waste Management—Divert 50% from landfill Returnable and Recyclable Packaging**—Leaf personal light packing materials include recyclable corrugated cardboard and polyethylene bag. The use of recyclable or returnable packaging can reduce the amount of landfill for the building project. 1 point

Credit 2.2 **Construction Waste Management—Divert 75% from landfill Returnable and Recyclable Packaging**— Leaf personal light packing materials include recyclable corrugated cardboard and polyethylene bag. The use of recyclable or returnable packaging can reduce the amount of landfill for the building project. 1 point

Credit 3.3 **Resource Reuse—30% furniture and furnishings Reuse**—Leaf personal light is designed for durability with a 5-year warranty and can be reused on many building projects. LEED credits may be achieved when reusing or purchasing used materials on a project. 1 point

Credit 4.1 **Recycled Content—10% (post-consumer + 1/2 pre-consumer)** Leaf personal light may contribute to this credit as it contains 30% recycled content. Leaf personal light contains 22% post-consumer recycled content and 8% pre-consumer recycled content. 1 point

Credit 4.2 **Recycled Content—20% (post-consumer + 1/2 pre-consumer)** Leaf personal light may contribute to this credit as it contains 30% recycled content. Leaf personal light contains 22% post-consumer recycled content and 8% pre-consumer recycled content. 1 point

Credit 4.5 **Low-Emitting Materials—Systems furniture and seating** Leaf personal light meets the requirements of both Option A (GREENGUARD® Certified) and Option C (BIFMA X7.1 – 2005, CIR dated 9/20/2006), but may not be in the scope for this LEED credit.
