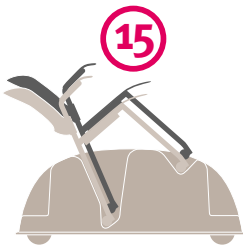

Moving/Lifting

Pull or lift your Caper chair using the convenient handhold on the back of the chair.

All Caper multipurpose stacking chairs—with or without arms and with or without casters—are lightweight, weighing eleven pounds or less.



Stacking

Stacking chairs—with or without arms and with or without casters—stack up to 6 on the floor and 15 on a cart. If the bottom chair has casters, a stack of up to 6 chairs can be transported without a cart.



To stack chairs: Position the top chair so that its legs are in front of the arm supports of the lower chair.

Maintenance/Cleaning

Molded Seat and Back

Wash injection-molded thermoplastic seat and back with a soft cloth soaked in mild detergent and warm water. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a soft cloth.

FLEXNET™ Seat

Dust or vacuum seat as needed using a soft vacuum-upholstery attachment.

Tubular Steel Frame


Wash chair frame with a soft cloth soaked in mild detergent and warm water. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a soft cloth.

A periodic inspection of chair components and fasteners should be made to ensure that the chair is structurally intact and functioning properly. Damaged and broken parts should be replaced and loose fasteners tightened.

Note: Caper chairs are not intended for outdoor use.
