### **MARNING**


Disconnect power before installation. Failure to do so can cause electrical shock and personal injury.

Electrically interconnected units must be mechanically interconnected.

Note: An Adapter is used with Festoon Connector to span from one frame to another when Frames are connected with Connector Tube.


# Assembly Instructions:




1. Insert Adapter into Power Harness Port closest to installer. Make sure Clip on Harness fully engages onto Ramp on Adapter

Insert end of Festoon
 Connector into Adapter. Make
 sure clip on Adapter fully
 engages onto Festoon
 Connector.




Connect other end of Festoon
 Connector to Power Harness on

 onto Festoon Connector.








A Change of Height Jumper Harness or

**B** Festoon Jumper (FT154.1)


# **Assembly Instructions:**



1. Connect Power Harness of different heights together with Jumper Harness (A). Make sure Clip on Power Harness fully engages onto Jumper Harness.

1. Connect Power Harnesses of different heights together with Festoon Jumper. Make sure Clip on Power Harness fully engages onto Festoon Jumper.

# **Disassembly for Recycling:**

# Materials Identification and Segregation:

Where possible, plastic components are marked with ASTM recycling codes. Use these codes to identify material type for recycling. Non marked components should be treated as mixed plastic. Ferrous metals can be identified using a small magnet for recycling. Non-ferrous metals should be separated and recycled separately.

To disassemble product, reverse the above installation steps.
